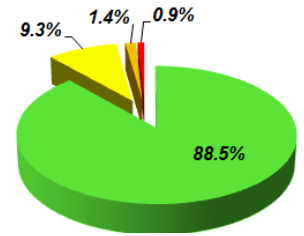

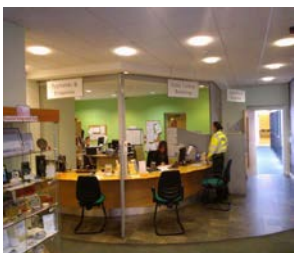

GENERAL PRACTICE SERVICES - THORPE ASTLEY

With a desire for locally-based GP services in Thorpe Astley; East Leicestershire and Rutland Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) is currently considering an application by a General Practice to open a branch surgery at Thorpe Astley Community Centre. However, given the workload involved in running a branch surgery and the complexity of general practice, it is important to ensure the proposal is sustainable, with a positive long-term outcome on all patients of the practice.



Therefore, the Town Council is supporting an initiative by NHS England and the CCG to engage with the community over the forthcoming months to ascertain from residents views on the potential future primary care service in Thorpe Astley. MILLFIELD HALL REFURBISHMENT

Regular hirers of the Millfield Hall at Braunstone Civic Centre may be aware that the room is in need of refurbishment and maintenance work. Over the last few months the Town Council has been successful in attracting funding for major refurbishment to the hall and the Council is pleased to advise that

the following work will be carried out between Monday 5th October and Monday 16th November 2015.

- New insulation and roofing work to replace the top covering of the roof
- New heating and air conditioning systems
- New ceiling tiles and replacement of fluorescent tubes to new LED lighting
- New stage and room curtains
- Varnish and refurbishment of existing wooden floor

During the first and last week scaffolding will erected and dismantled to the outside of the Millfield Hall. Access to the Braunstone Civic Centre will be open as usual and all other rooms will be unaffected by the work being carried out. Once complete, the work will greatly improve the function hall for all hirers.
