## **CRIME STATISTICS**

In 2014 there were 1241 crimes reported, which is 11.3% more offences than in 2013 (1115 crimes reported). Across the Leicestershire Police Area in 2014, 80396 crimes were reported, which is a 5.2% decrease compare to 2013 when 84783 crimes were reported.

Crimes committed the most in 2014 in Braunstone Town and Thorpe Astley:

- Anti-Social Behaviour 249 crimes reported, which is 12.6% (36 incidents) less than in 2013; this reduction being slightly higher than the County average (a reduction of 10.7%)
- Vehicle crime 293 crimes reported, which is 51% (99) more than in 2013, across the County the increase was 1.1%.
- Burglary 175 reported crimes, which is 2.3% (4) more than in 2013, less than the average across the County, which showed an increase of 4%.
- Criminal damage and arson 172 crimes reported, which is 20.3% (29) more than in 2013, this compared to a decrease across the County, 9.3% reduction.

The main concern for the local beat team at the moment is the significant increase of vehicle crime which has risen by 51% in 2014 compared to 2013, which is 4.1% of all vehicle crimes (7012) reported in whole Leicestershire, where vehicle crime has risen by 1.1% in 2014 compared to 2013.

There have been recent arrests in connection with vehicle crime in the area.

Attached are comparative figures for 2012-2014 for the Thorpe Astley and Braunstone Town Neighbourhood Beat Area and for the Leicestershire Police Area. Percentage change is indicated in 2013 compared to 2012 and in 2014 compared to 2013.







In January 2015 there were 80 crimes reported in Braunstone Town and Thorpe Astiey area, which is 19.2% (19) offences less than in December 2014 where 99 cases were reported. When comparing to the same period in the last year, the number of crimes is almost the same -81 reported in January 2014.

In Leicestershire Police Area crimes reported in January 2015 (5754) have gone down by 1.5% since December 2014 where 5839 cases were reported. It is also 6.6% less when comparing to January 2014 where 6162 crimes were reported.

#### Vehicle crime:

There were 28 vehicle crimes reported in December 2014 and 20 cases reported in January 2015. Even the fact that vehicle crimes has dropped since December, when comparing January 2014 and January 2015 – at the moment the vehicle crime is 81.8% higher (11 reported in January 2014).

Across the Leicestershire Police Area in the same period in 2015, 760 vehicle crimes were reported, which is a 34% increase comparing to January 2014 when 567 vehicle crimes were reported.

#### Anti-social Beahviour

There were 13 incidents reported in December 2014 and 16 incidents reported in January 2015. In January 2014, 13 incidents were reported so ASB has increased by 23.1%.

In the Leicestershire there were 1141 anti-social behaviours reported (January 2015) which is 21.8% less than in January 2014 where 1459 crimes were reported.

#### Burglary

We can see decrease in burglaries in the area with 13 reported in December 2014 and 9 reported in January 2015. That is 40% less than in January 2014.

In January 2015 burglaries has dropped by 19.1% (649 reported) in Leicestershire Police Area comparing to January 2014 (802 burglaries reported).

#### **Criminal Damage**

Criminal damage is still higher than at the beginning of last year. In December 2014 - 16 incidents were reported and in January 2015 – 15. This is 36.4% more than in January 2014 (11 crimes reported).

There has been slight increase by 8.3% in criminal damage and arson across Leicestershire Police Area from 636 cases reported in January 2014 to 689 cases reported in January 2015.
