# **Background to the Decision**

Louise Allen, Leicestershire Adult Learning Service, had completed an application form for Activities in Braunstone Town Community Library, to request use of rooms at Thorpe Astley Community Centre to host a Story In A Box Session in the library for 4-11 years old. The event is due to take place on Wednesday  $24^{th}$ July, 2.00pm-3.30pm. However, on checking the booking diary, this date was not available.

# Authority for Decision

Community Development Committee on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023 approved a scheme (attached at Appendix 2) and application process for applications from organisations who wish to run community events in the Braunstone Town Community Library (minute 42).

Under the Town Council's Scheme of Delegation, specific delegation 4 (b) enables the Chief Executive & Town Clerk to "determine applications received in consultation with the Officer Management Team and Chair of Community Development Committee (including, where possible, the Library Consultation Group)".

Consultation has been undertaken with the Management Team on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2024 and with the Chair of Community Development Committee on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Both were happy that the application met the scheme criteria and should be approved.

## **Alternative Options Considered and Rejected**

Following consultation with the Leicestershire Adult Learning Service team and on checking our booking system, a new date of Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2.00pm to 3.30pm had been booked.
